Update On St. Patrick's Church Windows - In consultation with the Finance Chair, we are proceeding with the project to completely restore the stained glass window depicting St. Peter, (located at the west stairwell leading to choir loft). Traditional Glassworks from Westport have determined this window requires a complete restoration. The work will begin by installing a new protective glazing and an interior sealed vapor barrier by mid-October, which will then allow the company to remove and complete the interior frame maintenance with the stained glass installation expected by late November. The cost for this intensive project is \$42,400.00. We have also asked for a costing on installation of vented protective tempered glass or Lexan for the remaining windows (which are determined to be in good shape) as well as scraping/painting of window frames. We will continue to update you as further information is received.
